## COSSONINAE OF MARCUS ISLAND

(Col., Curculionidae)

Specimens examined: 2 males and 3 females, Marcus Island, 3. V, 1952, S. F. SAKAGAMI leg.

The present specimens were collected from a rotten log of *Tournefortia* argentea. Furthermore, Aleurites moluccana and Pandanus odoratissimus have been informed by SWEZEY (1954) as host plants of this species in Hawaii. This species is widely distributed in Indo-Pacific islands, e. g., Ceylon, the Seychelles, Rodriguez Island, the Marquesas Islands, the Samoan Islands, the Hawaiian Islands and Guam Island, but it has not hitherto been recorded from so far north as Marcus Island.
